Dear Fire Station 7 Citizen:

Who do you call when a fire breaks out, when there is a medical emergency, or an automobile accident? What would happen if there was no fire truck, no ambulance, no local response? With more than 50 members of the Fire Company serving as first responders the Rock Hall Volunteer Fire Company stands ready and willing to help in any way possible, *BUT we must have the proper equipment to serve the needs of the community!*

Our first responders spend more than 14,000 hours annually responding to emergency situations and sharpening their skills as firefighters and emergency medical technicians. You should be aware that our coverage area extends more than 150 square miles, includes 12 marinas, thousands of acres of farm land, and more than 4,000 Kent County individuals and businesses (7,000+ seasonally).

We manage our finances prudently and are always on the lookout for the smart way to support our community. While we do receive support from state and local government, more than 60% of our revenue is generated from our many fundraising activities (such as Fireworks, Booster Campaign, Gun Bash, Bike Fest, Taste of Rock Hall, our many cookouts, etc.!). We generate enough revenue to support our operating expenses, but the substantial cost of replacing firefighting and emergency response equipment requires that we reach out to the community for additional support.
